CHECKSHEET

The Global and International Studies minor is intended to recognize, for undergraduate students in any major, the completion of an education abroad program, foreign language competency, and related advanced coursework. Ideally, the language, international, and advanced study should be integrated around some thematic or geographical focus.

Requirements: 18–30 credits, with at least 6 credits at the 400-level (see *below*)

- I. 12th-credit-level proficiency in one foreign language** (demonstrated by course work or examination)
